AACC Activities

- 2015 AACC Annual Meeting & Clinical Lab Expo in Atlanta, Georgia
- Establishment of a Universal Sample Bank
 - 700 healthy donors from meeting delegates
 - Primary goal of establishing a universal 99th percentile for troponin
 - Sample sets will be available for purchase
- Continued success and growth of the Lab Tests Online web site
 - 37 million visits up 68% over 2014
 - 32 LTO articles reviewed and updated
 - 2 new feature articles (POC and Patient Blood Management) and 7 news item articles
- Announcing a new Journal, The Journal of Applied Laboratory Medicine
 - International, peer reviewed publication showcasing applied research on clinically relevant lab topics

AACC Activities

 - Develop a position statement and supporting materials.
 - Presentation at President's Session of 68th AACC Annual Meeting
- Advocacy program covers a wide range of topics important to laboratory medicine.
