Most Societies today have a website


Less than half have electronic educational resources

#### IFCC Website accession 2016




620 respondents

Do you receive the IFCC eNews?








#### IFCC eJIFCC visibility 2016

Do you receive the eJIFCC?




605 respondents60 % do not read it

### Awareness of IFCC activities 2016 Survey

- > % of respondents aware of:
  - > EB activities/TF: 37.3%
  - > CPD activities: 31.7%
  - > EMD activities: 32.0%
  - > SD activities: 35.9%

At least 2/3 of membership is unaware of IFCC activities
