


#### **Academic publishing**

- Different things to different people
- Books, research papers



















#### Digital publishing

- Portable document format –PDF
- Developed by Adobe- early 1990s
- Share documents between users of different platforms
- Adoption slow initially
- Acrobat Reader 2.0





#### Digital publishing within IFCC

- eJIFCC
- eNewsletter







#### **Traditional PDF**

- 2 dimensional
- Designed for paper documents
- Isolated technology, not designed to merge with HTML5





#### **Beyond PDF**

- 4-dimensional documents
- Incorporate audio and video





#### The use of textbooks

- Billion dollar industry
- Printed textbooks expensive
- Developing countries member countries of IFCC





#### Student survey

- 99% own one smart device
- 93% laptops
- 78% smartphones
- 35% tablets
- 79% students using a digital textbook 63% in 2011
- USA- \$12 Billion on textbooks; 27% on digital textbooks

#### ePub

- an e-book file format with the extension .epub which can be downloaded and read on devices like smartphones, tablets, computers, or ereaders.
- International Digital Publishing Forum
- Official standard in 2007
- EPUB is the most widely supported vendorindependent XML-based (as opposed to PDF) ebook format; that is, it is supported by the largest number of hardware readers



#### ePub

- widely used on many software readers such as iBooks on iOS and Google Books on Android.
- iBooks also supports the proprietary iBook format, which is based on the EPUB format but depends upon code from the iBooks app to function.



#### ePub

- ePub 2.0 October 2007
- ePub 3.0 November 2014 precise layout or specialized formatting; HTML5; MathML support
