10.9.1. PR Brochures

Use of IFCC documents by National Society Members

Improvement of the traceability (downloads, dwell time, frequency) on the use of the documents produced by the different IFCC functional units by the members of the National Societies and Regional Federations has been identified as a must by the C-PR since this would allow increasing the visibility of IFCC. At the present time this seems difficult to achieve but some metrics should be available in the near future with the help of our web master Ms Janine Grant. As for the download of a particular document (e.g.: article from the eJIFCC Journal) this is possible with the present web site structure but will take a little more time. Furthermore, Janine has proposed having the IFCC web front page promoting the new/updated material and posted in social media. This however requires some work to remove any obsolete information.

10.9.3. PR Posters

Magdalena Krintus, had offered, during the last C-PR meeting in Madrid, to develop a standing poster for the promotion of IFCC at different venues. This is now done and will be presented during the EFLM meting in Warsaw. She should be congratulated for the quality of the graphics as well as of the content.

10.9.4. Publicity

The 1stInternational Congress on Personalized Health Care

This event was held in Montreal in June 2016. I made a presentation on the added-value of laboratory medicine. I have informed the members of the C-PR that if they would consider attending local meetings where promotion of pathology/IFCC would be useful, CPD could reimburse registration fees within limits and with approval of the CPD & C-PR Chairs. I also proposed that all should look for opportunities to participate to Administrator Associations annual meetings. We should also discuss the possibility of having administrators be part of Laboratory medicine meetings by participating or by being included in targeted symposia.

10.9.5. Miscellaneous PR Projects

Ramon Deulofeu has proposed to look into the possibility of producing short videos on laboratory input & impact on Patient care. He has provided a link as an example https://vimeo.com/106282557. This type of material could be produced locally according to the needs of the environment and then posted on social media.

Material already exists on Know Pathology and LAV. Don't want to waste money 'reinventing the wheel'. What message do we want to communicate and to whom? Work with LAV and KPKH exploring where we could help.

10.2.1.2.1 Labs are Vital Consortium

The Board, chaired by Michael Oellerich, has held 2 regular conference calls for the Board Meeting, to which I participated as Clinical Editor on behalf of the IFCC. I have also provided Michael the abstract, the presentation and the text published in the IFCC eNewsletter. It should eventually be posted on the LRV website. The LRV program has been revitalized and for the time being essentially steered by the ASCP and Abbott. The LRV website has posted 30 or more Podcasts or videos since February 2016 at http://www.labsarevital.com/. El Microscopio provided a number of them. At least 10K likes were registered on Facebook. There is less activity on LinkedIn. Topics are varied. Funding is provided for 2016 and we will have to see what happens for 2017. A Board Meeting was scheduled for September but a definite date is, as of today, not set.




Web Metrics:

Note, a large amount of dynamic metric information is available via Google Analytics. For consistency the same metrics are reported here as in previous reports with some additions. Specific information is available on request.



Demographics Overview indicates key age group continues to be 25-34 with ~60% female.








Content Drilldown top 10 page paths indicate CPD page highest, followed by home page, EB, CC, SD and EMD.

The IFCC LinkedIn group grow 15% last year reaching **3189 members**.


Group administrator is requested to approve any post from any group member. There are no rules or policies to define whether or not a post should be approved.

In the last period, members became more active and started discussions. However, these posts did not start discussions between members.


Unfortunately, large service changes has been made by LinkedIn and detailed group statistics are no longer available.




