1. Discussion Items

1.1 Confirmation of minutes

Previous minutes accepted by all attendees.

1.2 Term of Reference finalisation

Term of Reference accepted by all attendees. Finalised ToR to be published on IFCC website.

1.3 Opinion piece review

CM travelling and yet to review the manuscript. TPL has streamlined the opinion piece due to word count restrictions, it was agreed that the manuscript should be an overview, not a detailed review. TPL suggested heading format rather than questions and to remove 'trueness' as it appears to be an ambiguous term. RZ suggested the addition of specialised analytical detail. BC suggested opinion piece to be kept to basic validation and specialised detail to follow.

TPL asked if MU is part of validation or a post validation process. MT suggested the removal of MU. RZ suggested that MU may be more useful for clinicians TPL agreed that the opinion piece should focus on pure evaluation details and stay within a restricted scope and give separate acceptance range for each criteria. It was agreed to remove MU and possibly include a statement for how to access method performance for clinical purpose.

TPL asked whether data reporting section should include industry data from manufacturers, IVD guidelines and the fact that these should meet routine laboratory validation standards in reporting. Details
